ER Criminal Justice Team will study the Barmore Report to determine of any the recommendations from the March 2010 Report apply to supporting the new Civilian Review Board.		
Members of the ER Criminal Justice Team will take the Citizen Police Academy training to learn how to help organize on a neighborhood level.
